Preserving and protecting covered bridges

HAMDEN - Hamden resident Wayne Marshfield will give a presentation on the history of covered bridges in Delaware County at the Cannon Free Library, Elm Street, Delhi, on July 19 at 6 p.m.

Marshfield is the president of the New York State Covered Bridge Society, which boasts 200 members from New York and other states. The organization's mission is to protect and preserve covered bridges.

At one time, Marshfield said, there were between 12,000 and 14,000 covered bridges in the United States. Now, there are between 500 and 600. New York, he said, once had roughly 300 covered bridges. That number has dwindled to 23. Delaware County had 57 covered bridges at one time, he said, but now has four historic covered bridges, six total.

Delaware County owns and maintains the covered bridges in Downsville, Hamden and Delhi. He is thankful the county maintains the bridges, he said.

In 2000, Delaware County restored the Hamden Covered Bridge, which spans the west branch of the Delaware River, at an approximate cost of \$700,000. The Downsville Covered Bridge, which spans the east branch of the Delaware River on Bridge Street, cost nearly \$1 million to restore.

Marshfield's interest in covered bridges was

spurred approximately 29 years ago when the Hamden Covered Bridge was closed for repairs. He approached the bridge on foot, he said, and saw fisherman barbecuing with a charcoal grill in the middle of the closed bridge. Not only was it a fire hazard, he said, but the incident motivated him to run for public office with the campaign slogan, "Save the covered

bridge."

It worked, he said. He has been Hamden supervisor since.

Covered bridges have a positive economic impact on their communities. He often sees people stopping to photograph the Hamden Covered Bridge, and the nearby park is frequently filled with visitors enjoying the view, fishing or floating and boating. "They're sce-

nic and functional," he said of covered bridges. "They are also unique, just like a human being. Unique in their own way," he said. Some have Long trusses, some have arched trusses and some have windows, he said by way of example.

His favorite memory of the Hamden Covered Bridge, he said, involves a donkey. Years ago, he said, Hamden resident Ken Budine, who has since moved out of the area, was attempting to walk his donkey through the covered bridge. Normally, he said, it wouldn't be a problem. "They think of it like a barn," Marshfield said. But, Budine's stubborn donkey refused to cross the bridge and the only way to get him across, Marshfield said while laughing, was to walk him through the river. "Now that was funny," Marshfield said.

New Yorkers can choose 'X' gender on driver's license, ID

Governor Kathy Hochul announced that New Yorkers will have the option to choose "X" as a gender marker on their driver license, learner permit, or non-driver ID card at all Department of Motor Vehicle offices statewide, beginning June 24. This change is being implemented in accordance with the state's Gender Recognition Act. The legislation provides expanded protections for transgender and non-binary New Yorkers by making it easier for people to change their names, change their sex designation and change their birth certificates to reflect their identity.

New Yorkers who have an existing driver license, learner permit, or non-driver ID will have the option to change the gender marker on their photo ID from "M" or "F" to "X", and those who are applying for a state photo ID for the first time will have the option to choose "X". This can be done by completing the application for permit, driver license or non-driver ID Card (MV-44).

Customers who do not want to visit a DMV office to change their existing ID document will have the option to change their gender designation through an online transaction beginning in July 2022.

The announcement comes as part of advancements in LGBTQ+ equity Hochul secured in the 2023 state budget. The budget includes \$13.5 million for the

Department of Health to support the LGBTQ+ community and more than doubles annual LGBTQ+ Health and Human Services funding. In addition, the budget includes legislation requiring state agencies to provide an option for individuals to mark their gender or sex as a non-binary "X" on all state forms that collect gender or sex information. Agencies are also required to include that information in data collection. The budget also enables transgender New Yorkers to change their names or gender designations on marriage certificates without leaving their dead names on them.

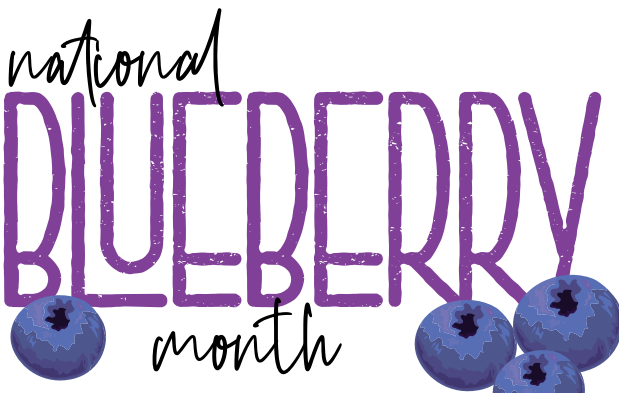

Some surprising benefits of blueberries

8. Blueberries may be an anti-aging treatment. Oxidative DNA damage occurs in every cell in the body each day, according to Healthline. DNA damage is one reason why people grow older. High antioxidants in blueberries can neutralize some free radicals that are implicated in DNA damage.
